It depends on many factors whether we will get there or not.
There is more than one path to get there.
There is also more than one pitfall, preventing the societies to move closer.

Outcome of the imagination exercise: desired scenarios and forward lessons to avoid pitfalls.



Essay contest

The participants are invited to share their vision and ideas on Ecocivilisation in a short **essay paper**.

Alternatively, **choose two articles and briefly explain** why they help us understand future scenarios.

The best contributions will be published as a featured article in our [CBA CONVERSATIONS](#) section.

Authors will be awarded a free participation in one of our paying seminars of choice and, possibly, engaged in the subsequent Ecocivilisation sessions. Short essays should be, ideally, up to **2500 characters** long and may not exceed 3500 characters (incl. spaces).

We will select the best ones, discuss them in Part II and III and publish them on CBA CONVERSATIONS.

We will provide editing in agreement with the author.

Language: English; other languages are also accepted, just write the title and an intro also in English.
