













Level of circular activity





Primary focus and drivers of circular tranformation


What is your organisation's primary focus in tackling the circular opportunities?







Conclusions



Questionnaire clear and overall well understood.

- Minor textual improvements needed;
- Additional explanatory notes to be developed;
- Questionnaire enhancement upcoming: more background information, possibilities for additional data import and analysis;

Results overall confirmative:

- percentage of frontrunners similar to those of SID banka, expected favouring bias due to voluntary participation;

CAS Report to be improved with comparative statistics and augmented advisory service, including:

- industry comparisons;
- additional data imports (publicly available company information);
- increased relevance for transformation managers (overall company result and "breakthrough" projects contribution to circularity), banks and other users;
